Pool Season 2014!!!

The 2014 pool season will be here soon!!! The Shallowford Lakes Association pool opens on Saturday, May 24 at 11:00 a.m. The season runs through Labor Day weekend, closing on Monday, September 1.

If you haven't joined the pool before, or it's been awhile, be sure to check out the various affordable membership options** that are available to SLA residents whose association dues are in good standing:

Community Watch

Anytime you see suspicious activity – whether it's a person, a vehicle, or something that just doesn't seem normal - please call the Sheriff's office (727-2112 or 911). The more timely and specific information you can provide, the better! You may make anonymous reports if you would prefer to do so. However, if you want to speak to a sheriff, ask for it! If you want a call back, make sure the operator has all of your contact information. The more vocal we are as a community, the better response and visibility we will have with the Sheriff's office. Our Deputies **DO NOT** mind being called to investigate a situation that seems abnormal.

It is also important to **keep an eye on vacant properties** in the neighborhood and to contact the Sheriff if you see suspicious activity.

All residents with email addresses on file will receive timely updates about any criminal activity in the neighborhood. You may also contact Jen Hayden at 749-1902 or shallowford.lakes@gmail.com if you have information that needs to be shared with the neighborhood in order to keep all residents informed of criminal activity. Share this information with your neighbors in the event they do not use email.
